



# UScellular + Premier Wireless Sales Enablement Guide (K-12 Focus)

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## Overview

This guide equips sales reps with tools to engage K-12 decision-makers around school safety and connectivity challenges, highlighting how Premier Wireless and UScellular jointly deliver reliable, grant-eligible communication solutions.

## Common Challenges & Pain Points

- No backup when Wi-Fi or phones go down
- Outdated POTS lines that don't support modern safety protocols
- Buses without real-time connectivity or GPS tracking
- Poor coverage in rural areas
- Panic buttons and radios that don't communicate across teams
- Funding concerns and limited internal IT support

## Objection Handling + Email Responses

Common objections you may encounter during outreach or follow-up:

- "We already have a provider."
- "We don't have the budget."
- "We're just exploring."

## Persona-Based Messaging

### Superintendents / District Leaders:

- Focus: campus-wide safety, funding, accountability
- Messaging: "End-to-end emergency communication solutions that reduce risk, improve incident response, and qualify for federal safety grants."

### IT Directors:

- Focus: network performance, failover, minimal lift
- Messaging: "Plug-and-play connectivity with SpeedFusion failover and full deployment support — all with low IT overhead."

## Transportation Directors:

- Focus: driver safety, GPS visibility, compliance
- Messaging: “Connected bus solutions with Wi-Fi, GPS tracking, and driver communications that work in and out of coverage zones.”

## School Safety Officers / SRO Coordinators:

- Focus: reliable panic alerting, on-campus communication
- Messaging: “Reliable radios, emergency phones, and panic button systems with backup connectivity to ensure every call gets through.”

## LinkedIn Prospecting Messages

### Connection Request:

Hi [First Name] – I work with Premier Wireless, helping districts improve emergency communication and school safety — especially in areas where coverage gaps exist. Would love to connect!

### InMail 1: Safety Gaps

## Email 3: Objection – “We don't have the budget”

## Email 4: Real Examples

Subject: How other schools are solving comms gaps

## Call Scripts
